Lend **A** HAND BUILD A DREAM

- Step 1.** The global dream team conducts extensive surveys and identifies the area to setup the Dream Lab.
- Step 2.** Finalize the design, gather raw materials. Involve the local community to build the lab.
- Step 3.** The Global Dream team collaborates with volunteers.
- Step 4.** Identifies responsible volunteers to be permanent teachers for the lab. Conduct training sessions to empower the volunteers.
- Step 5.** Enrollment Day - the kids and adults are formally enrolled in the lab.
- Step 6.** The classes begin!
